### 3. Amendments

#### 3.1 Constitution - Addition of 'Webmaster'

Webmaster is currently missing from the constitution. The proposed wording is:

##### 2.5.10 THE WEBMASTER

The Webmaster shall be responsible for maintaining and updating the ISAA website.

Updating the Website includes:

- Liaising with the Records Officer to put up the years league results and any ISAA records from that year.
- Updating the Competition Calendar
- Updating the available Constitution and Rulebook and archiving any out of date documents
- Updating the contact information for a new committee

#### 3.2 Constitution - Outdoor Scores & Pins

Proposed outdoor scoring system is based on % people

#### 3.3 Constitution - Grace Year Athletes

##### Current Wording

##### 2.2.2.1 Conditions of eligibility for a "grace year;"

- Not a registered student of a third level institution, or -
- Are a registered student of a third level institution that is unable to obtain permission for affiliation with the Association from their current third level institution. This member(s) must provide written proof of inability to affiliate to the Association from the relevant authority within their institution prior to completing Article 2.2.3.
- If an athlete graduates between January & June, they will qualify for a grace year consisting of the Outdoor League 22/23 and the Indoor League 23/24 only.
- If an athlete graduates between July & December, they will qualify for a grace year consisting of the Indoor League 23/24 and the Outdoor League 23/24.

- 2.2.2.2 An athlete will only be eligible for a single grace year in the Association comprised of 1 (One) indoor and 1 (One) outdoor league within the same ISAA season.
- 2.2.3. Such students wishing to avail of a grace year must notify the Association Secretary in writing at least one month before the first scheduled Competition of the new Season.
- 2.2.4. Under exceptional circumstances, a student may be permitted to postpone their grace year by one Season only. The Committee has the power to award or deny such a postponement

### 3.4 *Proposal* - Barebow Intermediate

Based on increasing number of archers competing in the Barebow Category  
The aim is to create more competition and introduce more medals (overall fairness).

2.7.7.9 In order to compete in the BBO or BBF categories, an archer must not have scored more than the following at a single Intervarsity or official World Archery Member Association competition:

- 299 points with 60 arrows on a 40cm face at 18m;
- 299 points with 60 arrows on a tri-spot 40cm face at 18m;

2.7.7.10 In order to compete in the BIO or BIF categories, an archer must not have scored more than the following at a single Intervarsity or official World Archery Member Association competition:

- 399 points with 60 arrows on a 40cm face at 18m;
- 399 points with 60 arrows on a tri-spot 40cm face at 18m;

*(Only change is the article number)*

2.7.7.11 Any archer ineligible for the above categories shall compete in the BAO or BAF categories.

### What does this mean for current Barebow Advanced?

2.7.7.12 *An archer may never move down a category*

- Those who competed in the 2022/23 indoor league as BAF/BAO will remain in advanced.
- Those who scored 350 points after the first indoor 2022/23 intervarsity and continued to compete as BBF/BBO for the league will now enter the intermediate category.

*Barebow Intermediate for outdoors will be discussed at a later date once proper research is complete.*

## **VOTE:**

3.1 *Constitution* - Addition of 'Webmaster'

9 in favour , 0 in opposition, (Passed)

3.2 *Constitution* - Outdoor Scores & Pins

8 in favour , 1 in opposition (Passed) (DU voted no)

3.3 *Constitution* - Grace Year Athletes

10 in favour , 0 in opposition (Passed)

3.4 *Proposal* - Barebow Intermediate

10 in favour , 0 in opposition (Passed)

→ 9 clubs originally voted but late arrival of UU due to technical difficulties resulted in the change of 9 to 10 votes.

→ 10 colleges in attendance, majority of 7 was needed for quorum.

- Addition of adding a minimum distance for the outdoor scores for awarding pins.
- New shoot notice programme to be organised by Jervis for a trial run period.
